

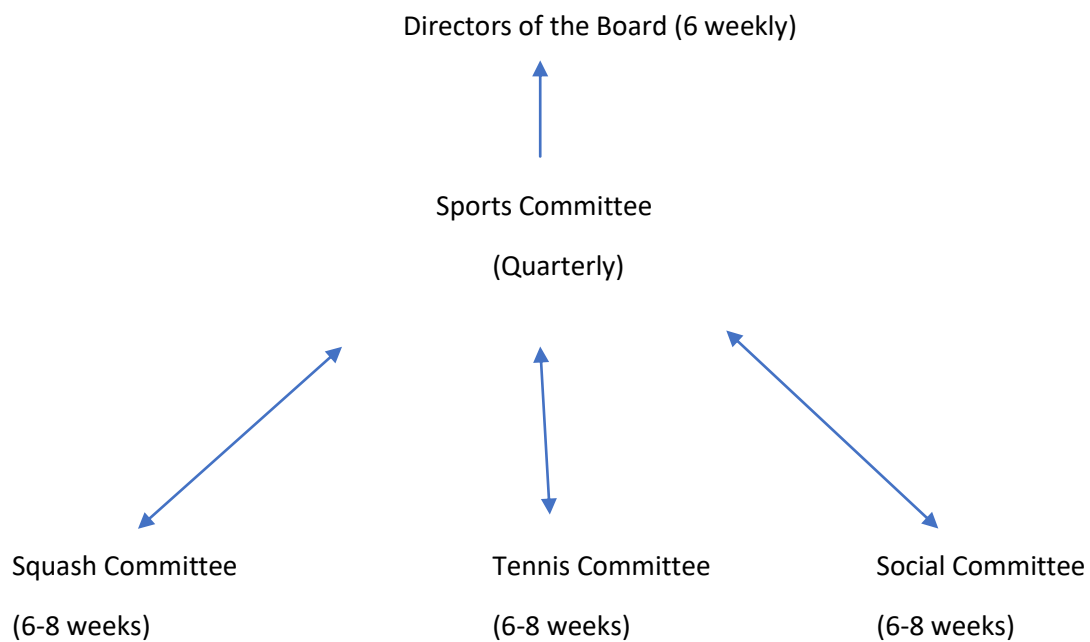


The Directors of Redland Green Club in an effort to increase communication to members have put together a brief explanation of how the Club functions through its committees
